LPS Statement

- Tom verbally presented SASGov statement on LPS
 - o Paper copies of statement were given to GB and GAPSA members in attendance
- GAPSA response to statement: SASGov statement is based upon incorrect information
 - o GAPSA President (Miles Owens) and Vice President (Rebecca Umbach) was in attendance, among other GAPSA representatives (e.g., Paul Welfer)
- Suggestions by SASGov GB on how to address LPS issue:
 - o Having a combined LPS and SAS social event
 - Informing GAPSA that there *might* be financial issues due to the reduced budget and asking if GAPSA might consider helping to address any financial issues *if* they arise.
 - o Breaking this issue into two pieces:
 - 1) How LPS left (process of leaving) what is the policy?
 - 2) Monetary aspect not necessarily related to *how* the issues arose but to focus on the fact that it *did* happen and there are issues that are arising as a consequence which need to be addressed.
- STATUS: SASGov Statement on LPSGov is TABLED until budget is finalized
 - Note: SASGov budget is anticipated to be finalized during second SASGov meteing (September 25th) and GAPSA budget is anticipated to be finalized during second GAPSA meeting (September 27th).
 - o **Hong** will present budget at the next SASGov GB meeting (September 25th)
