

SASgov GB minutes 10/9/2017

- Executive updates
 - President – elections for the new president will be held later in the meeting
 - Communications – emails from reps to their departments are still needed from 11 programs
 - Social – the wine and cheese event was successful, please come to future social events and encourage your peers to do the same
 - Finance – travel grant applications will open during the next finance committee meeting (this was voted on by the GB and passed)
 - Public Affairs – Nicole have been in meetings regarding “Ben talks”. The date we should all keep in mind is February 23rd. It is suggested that the talks will be 8 min instead of 10. Nicole wants peoples input regarding this.
 - Policy – Tom has worked on constitutional amendments and edited the LPS resolution.
 - As Tom is running for the position of President he is stepping down as the VP of Policy. Akshay thus called a special election for this position to be held at the next meeting (10/ 23) and Ida will send out an email about this to the department representatives.
